The Youth Advisory Board of the Ghana SRHR Alliance held a meeting to plan and make decisions for the Alliance's growth. Members reflected on their journey, received training, and developed a work plan for the year, focusing on strengthening collaboration and increasing youth SRHR knowledge.



National Dialogue on Zero Discrimination Day

In commemoration of Zero Discrimination Day, the UN in Ghana, in collaboration with state actors and youth-led CSOs, convened a national dialogue on discrimination on March 1st, 2024. During the event, the Ghana SRHR Alliance co-facilitated a breakout session on the same theme, drawing in more than 80 participants who shared valuable insights and experiences. The session, centered on Youth, Gender, and Intersectional Stigma for Marginalized Groups, resulted in a recommendation for the establishment of a National Youth Network to address discrimination.



Power To Youth

CSOs Learning Hub was established to enhance capacity of CSOs in lobbying, advocacy, and youth participation, involving 69 youth groups and CSOs in policymaking engagement and advocacy initiatives.

The recent workshop event focused on advocacy, sexual and reproductive health, family planning, and contraceptives, involving MoYs, YLOs, and CSOs from Savannah and Northern Region.

Project - Reproductive Health Education (RHE) Updates

Norsaac, recently recruited 50 young people across 3 districts who were trained as SRHR champions to implement RHE initiatives through community-centered programs such as durbars, community games, and RHE outreaches.



The three-day training equipped beneficiaries with knowledge on Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights, Adolescence and its Challenges, *Drug and Substance Abuse, STIs/HIV&AIDS, Menstruation and Menstrual Hygiene, Sex, Gender, and Gender Norms, SGBV, and Media Advocacy.* **Norsaac is a founding member of the Alliance.**



Presbyterian Health Ghana

Presbyterian Health, Over the period has increased skilled delivery in Talensi/Nabdam and Garu/Tempane districts, with 45 Community Health Committees participating in health decision-making in 9 health centers, 10 clinics, and 25 CHPS, and increasing fully functional CHPS.
